ART and CRAFT fun work

(1) Handprint Butterfly Craft

This is a simple craft made from a child's hand print cutouts.

Materials required:

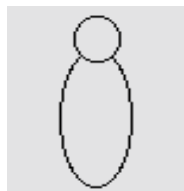
- A few pieces of coloured construction paper (stiffer paper makes a more durable butterfly)
- A pencil
- Scissors
- Glue, tape or a stapler
- Crayons, paint or markers
- Googly eyes (optional), A pipe cleaner



Trace a child's hand on a few pieces of coloured construction paper for atleast six times. These will be the butterfly's wings.



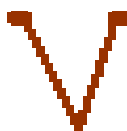
Cut out the tracings.



On a piece of dark construction paper, draw the butterfly's body (draw a long oval circle having a small circle at one end).



Tape or staple the handprint tracings to the butterfly's body, three on each side. The fingers should point outwards.

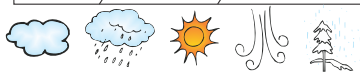


Fold a pipe cleaner into 'V' shape. Curl the ends a bit or roll them into balls. The folded pipe cleaner will be the butterfly's antennae.

Tape or staple the bent part of the pipe cleaner to the back side of the butterfly's head.



Either draw eyes on the butterfly's head or glue on the googly eyes. Decorate the wings with crayons or markers. You now have an attractive butterfly decoration. Attach it to your portfolio.

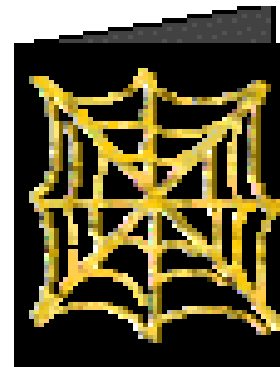


(2) Spider Web Card Craft

This scary paper spider web card is easy to make, using glue and glitter on construction paper.

Material required :

- Dark construction
- Glue
- Glitter
- Old newspaper (to work on)



Fold a piece of dark construction paper into half.



Working on an old newspaper, draw a spider web with glue on the front portion of the card. Start by drawing a series of intersecting lines.



After drawing the intersecting lines, draw the curved lines between them.



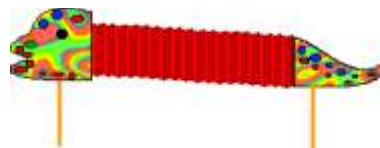
Sprinkle glitter on the glue web. Gently shake the picture so that the excess glitter slide off the spider web (onto the newspaper).

Let the glue dry (at least overnight). Draw a spider on the spider web and a spooky Halloween message.

(3) Dancing Lion or Dragon Toy

Material required :

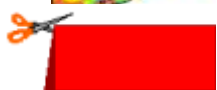
- Coloured paper
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers
- Glue, tape
- Two wooden barbeque skewers (or 2 straws or disposable chopsticks)
- Optional : glitter, feathers



Draw the head and tail of a lion or dragon on a piece of paper.



Cut the head and tail out and decorate with bright colours. Optional: Decorate with glitter and feathers.



Fold a piece of paper into half along the length. Cut along the fold so as to get two long rectangles.



Fold each piece of paper like a paper fan. Glue or tape the two pieces together, forming one long piece that will be the animal's body.



Glue or tape one end of the body to the head. Glue or tape the other end of the body to the tail.




(4)Rabbit Mask Craft


Materials required:

- Two plain white paper plates
- Pink construction paper or pink paint
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Glue
- Crayons, markers or paint
- Optional: Small pink pompom
- Optional: Elastic

Making the rabbit's ears: Either paint the centre of a plain white paper plate pink or cut out a circle from pink construction paper (it should be the same size as the inside of the plain white paper plate); then glue the pink paper circle to the centre of the plain white paper plate.

Cut the paper plate into half (the two halves will be the rabbit's ears).

Making the rabbit's face: Using a new plain white paper plate, cut a wedge (about 1/4th of the plate) out of the plain white paper plate (the large part of the plain white plate will be the rabbit's face).

Staple the ears to the face.

- 

Cut two eye holes in the face.

- 

Optional: Glue a small pink pompom to the centre of the face (this is the rabbit's nose).
Optional: Staple a piece of elastic (about a foot long) to the mask so as to keep it in place.

Decorate your mask with crayons, markers or paint. Don't forget to draw whiskers!

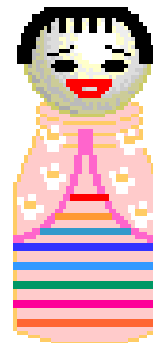


(5) Japanese Kokeshi Dolls

Kokeshi dolls are simple stylised Japanese toy dolls which originated in northern Japan. They are a major tourists attraction. They have a stalked body topped with a round head. In this craft, the base is a small plastic bottle and the head is a ping-pong ball.

Materials required :

- A ping-pong ball (or a styrofoam ball)
- A small, clean or empty plastic bottle, like a yogurt drink
- bottle or a vitamin bottle (or use somewhat small, white or plastic bottle)
- glue (quick fix)
- Translucent varnish.
- Small fine tipped paint brushes
- Markers



Glue the ping-pong ball or a styrofoam ball to the top of the small or plastic bottle. Let the glue set for a few minutes.



Give the body (the small, plastic bottle) a coat of paint (you can pick a simple white or beige or choose a less traditional bright color). Let the paint dry.



Using small fine tipped paint brushes or markers, draw the doll's facial features and hair (on the ping-pong ball). Let the paint dry.



Then decorate the body to represent a beautiful kimono (a traditional Japanese gown). Let the paint dry.
You now have made a beautiful and eye catching Kokeshi doll.
