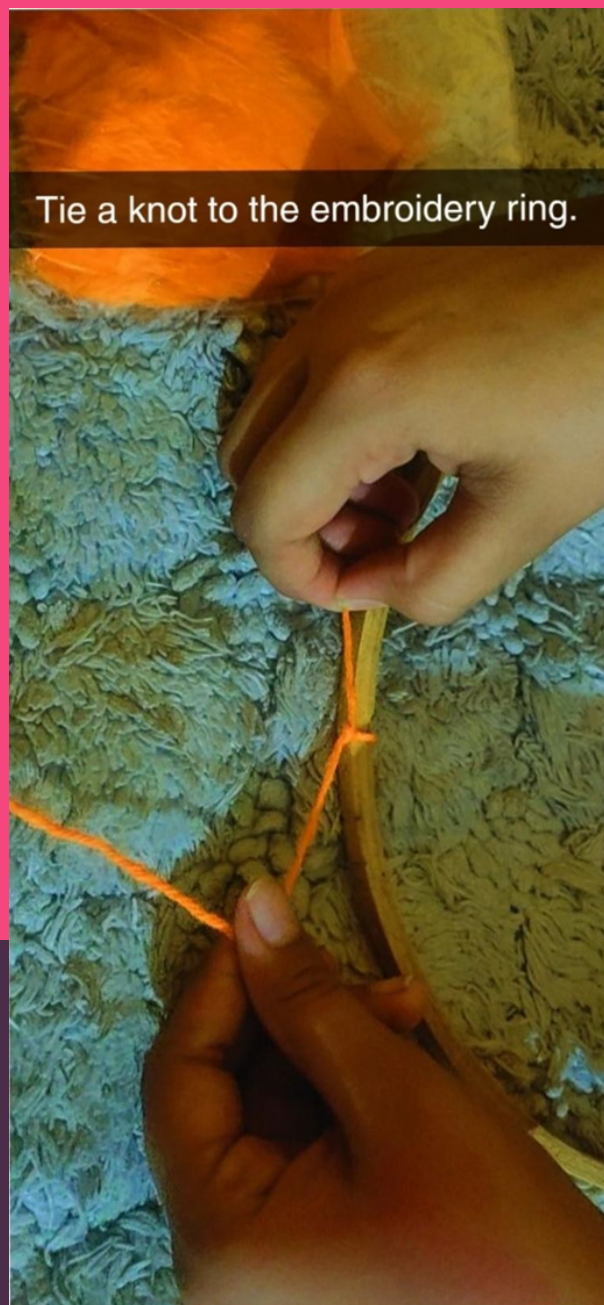

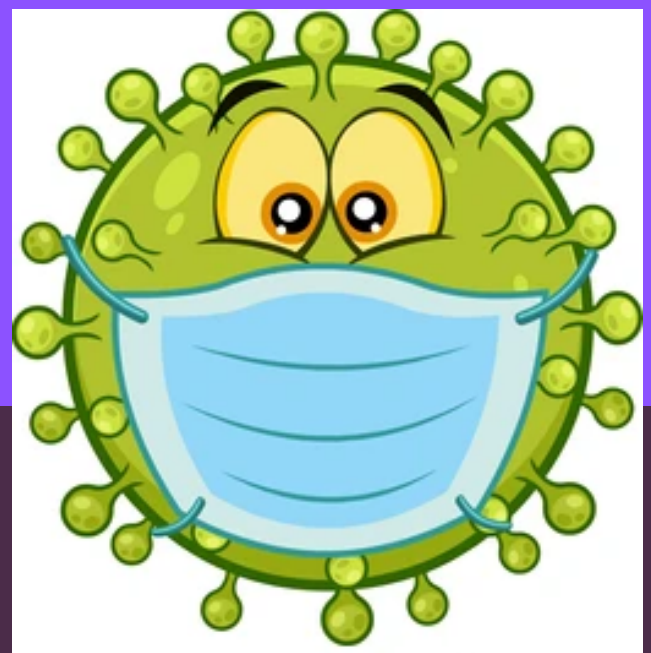

IMPORTANCE OF CHANTING SHLOKAS

The word 'shloka' is derived from the root (dhatu) 'shru' meaning 'to hear'.

The shloka is a poetic form used in Sanskrit language.

Let us know the benefits of chanting shlokas :

By chanting shlokas in a rhythmic form, one can gain peace of mind, improves concentration and enhances memory. It balances the blood flow throughout the body which reduces the stress.

In Hindhu tradition, there is a practice of chanting a shloka looking at one's own palm of both the hands. The hands are cupped in front of the face and the below given shloka is recited every morning after waking up.

IMPORTANCE OF CHANTING SHLOKAS

कराग्रे वसते लक्ष्मीः करमध्ये सरस्वती।
करमूले तु गोविन्द प्रभाते करदर्शनम्॥

This shloka means, that, to some extent everything is there in our own hands, by working hard we can gain wealth (Goddess Lakshmi), through practice and application of good knowledge we can become a scholar (Goddess Saraswathi) and Govinda (Lord Vishnu) is said to be the God of Ayurveda, by following good habits, we can gain good health.
